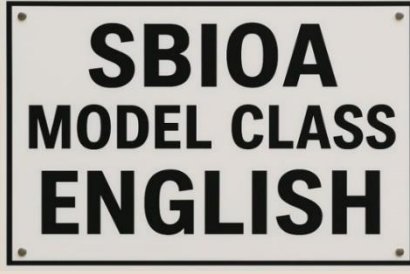

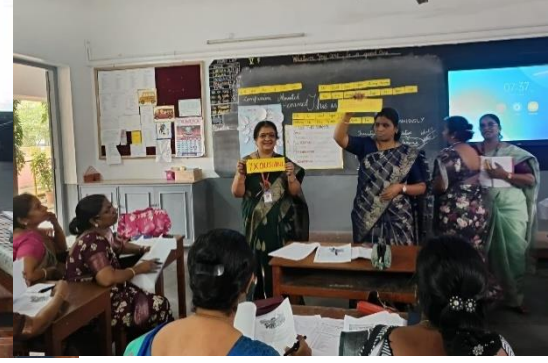
A model teaching session in English, Tamil, and Mathematics was conducted on 6th December 2025 for teachers handling Classes 6 to 9 across the four Chennai Schools. The programme witnessed an enthusiastic participation of around 98 teachers, making it a highly interactive and collaborative mini-workshop.

The English Model Teaching was effectively facilitated by Mrs. Miriam Veronica (JC), while the Tamil Model Teaching was led with expertise by Ms. R. Shantha (GS).

The Mathematics Model Class was skillfully demonstrated by Mrs. R. Sheela Rani (GS). Together, these sessions provided teachers with valuable pedagogical insights and practical strategies to enhance classroom instruction across the three subjects.

A model teaching session was conducted for the teachers handling Classes 6 to 9 across the four Chennai Schools under the SBIOA Educational Trust, Chennai. The session commenced with a gracious welcome, setting a warm and collegial tone. This was followed by an interactive icebreaker in which teachers enthusiastically guessed words based on clues—an effective demonstration of how to stimulate curiosity and activate learners' prior knowledge at the start of a lesson.

To highlight the integration of multimedia in teaching, Mrs. Miriam presented an insightful video on animal care, seamlessly transitioning into a visually engaging slide presentation on the young ones of animals. She also introduced the author of the lesson and displayed various teaching aids, offering teachers practical ideas for enriching classroom instruction. A spectrum of innovative classroom strategies was showcased to deepen teacher understanding. Participants observed how to guide students in identifying literary devices, how to design meaningful tasks such as framing sentences using lesson-based vocabulary, and how to engage learners through interactive unscrambling activities. Mrs. Miriam further demonstrated an effective approach to leading discussions on the oral value of the lesson, helping teachers infuse moral perspectives into language learning.

Overall, the model teaching session was insightful, well-structured and highly enriching. It effectively blended multimedia tools, vocabulary-building tasks, value-based discussions and grammar instruction. The demonstration provided teachers with a comprehensive and inspiring framework for delivering engaging, student-centred and pedagogically sound English lessons.

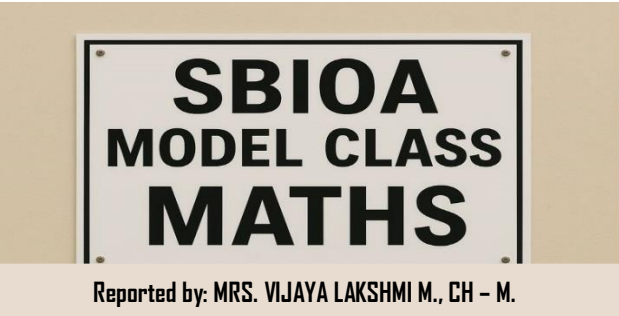

The Model Class for the Math teachers started with 14 dimensions story and highlighting strategies for teaching 3D shapes using net figures. The objective of the session was to demonstrate effective strategies for teaching three-dimensional shapes through hands-on learning.



Teachers were shown various examples of nets for shapes such as cubes, cuboids, pyramids, and cylinders. The facilitator highlighted common misconceptions students may face and shared methods to simplify complex concepts through visual representation. During the interactive segment, teachers actively participated in cutting, folding and assembling net templates. This practical activity demonstrated how learning



becomes meaningful when students engage with concrete materials. The session also emphasized integrating questioning techniques, collaborative learning and real-life applications. She also suggested to download GEOTEBRA 3D calculator app which is highly useful and informative.

The model class concluded with a discussion and reflection, where teachers shared feedback and classroom implementation ideas. Overall, the session was informative, engaging and effective, providing teachers with innovative approaches to make Mathematics more experiential and student-centred.

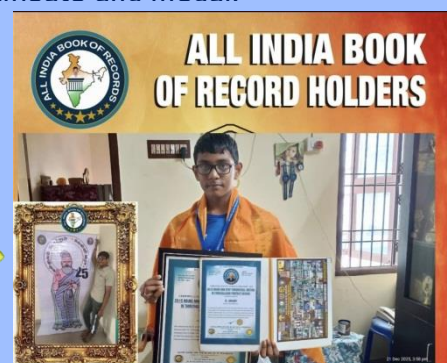

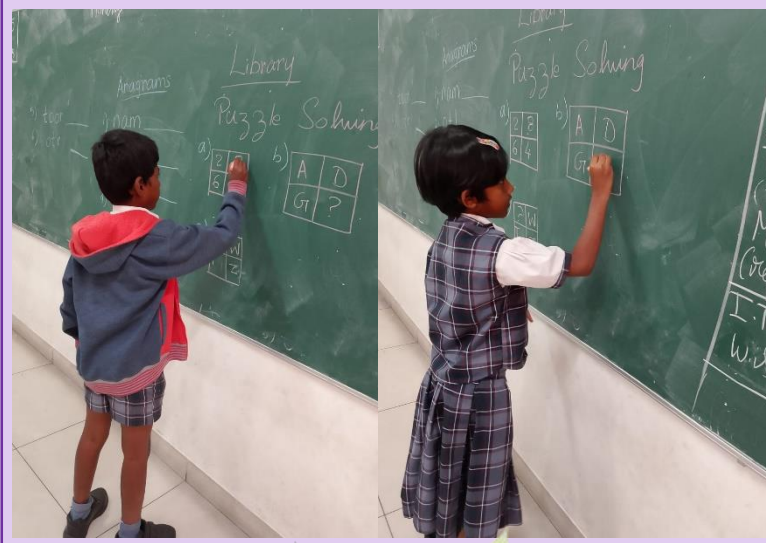

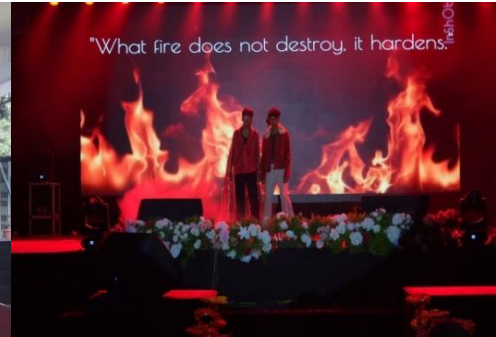
